### Position Summary

Technician performs quality services to support operations that cover a variety of routine and complex analytical procedures under supervision. Samples may include wine, juices, concentrate, and spirits. In addition to bench work, this role will take samples for analysis at tanks, barrels, tankers and manifolds.

### Responsibilities

- Performs analytical tests on wine with precision and accuracy in a timely manner
- Prepares reagents and standardized solutions
- Calibrates, operates and maintains laboratory equipment
- Prepares and maintains required reports and records accurately and on time
- Samples at tankers, manifolds, tanks and bottling lines for analyses
- Understands and adheres to the facility's hazardous material & safety procedures, and GMPs
- Monitors and maintains lab inventories, purchasing supplies as needed
- Follows procedures according to established standard operating procedures (SOP's) for quality; validates, reviews and updates SOPs as required
- Uses common sense and logic to identify erroneous data and troubleshoots malfunctioning equipment
- Other duties as assigned

### Minimum Qualifications

- AA Degree required, 4yr degree preferred in Chemistry, Agriculture, Enology or related Science
- 2 – 4 years' lab experience required (equivalent combination of education and experience is acceptable)
- Prior experience in method development, validation and documentation preferred
- Able to multitask.
- Computer literate with databases, spreadsheets, and word processing required

### Physical Requirements/Work Environment
