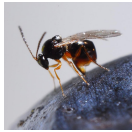

Release Permit for Damaging Spotted-Wing Drosophila Parasite Approved

OSU entomologist Vaughn Walton and colleagues report on a 10-year process of importing and obtaining a release permit of an important SWD parasitoid. This parasitoid will provide significant relief to the wine industry in high pressure seasons in the long run.
