As a seasonal field technician/laborer you will be issued a state vehicle to perform your job. Most work will occur outdoors while performing duties such as setting/checking survey traps for spongy moth, Japanese beetle, and other insects that threaten Oregon's agriculture. A typical schedule is 40 hours a week, Monday-Thursday.
